




STATISTICS

- THE PORT OF MOSES LAKE:
 - HAS 4,700 TOTAL ACRES OF LAND
 - OPERATES THE GRANT COUNTY INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT
 - OPERATES A MAJOR INDUSTRIAL PARK 1500 ACRES.
 - MAINTAINS A FOREIGN TRADE ZONE
 - CERTIFIED AS A SPACE PORT
 - HAS IT'S OWN WASTE WATER TREATMENT FACILITY
 - ARFF TRAINING FACILITY

GRANT COUNTY INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT

- COMPRISED OF 5 RUNWAYS
- MAIN RUNWAY IS 13,503 FEET LONG
- 3200 ACRES
- THREE FIXED BASE OPERATORS
- COMMERCIAL PILOT FLIGHT PROGRAM
THROUGH BIG BEND COMMUNITY COLLEGE
- AIRCRAFT RESCUE FIREFIGHTING TRAINING
FACILITY (ARFF)

- THE PORTS INDUSTRIAL PARK IS COMPRISED OF
 - 48 BUILDINGS
 - 54 TENANTS
 - 1500 TOTAL ACRES
- FOREIGN TRADE ZONE – 5 USERS THAT PROVIDE OVER 1000 JOBS TO THE MOSES LAKE AREA.
