The meeting will be audio and video recorded to be accessible during or after the meeting.

The meeting will feature a roundtable discussion on "Moving People: Airport, Cruise Ships, and Tourism." This roundtable is part of the final stage of the Port's three-year strategic planning process called the Century Agenda.
