## APPROVED MINUTES COMMISSION SPECIAL MEETING NOVEMBER 22, 2011

The Port of Seattle Commission met in a special meeting Tuesday, November 22, 2011, in the Beijing Room at Seattle-Tacoma International Airport, Seattle, Washington, for the purpose of holding a Commission retreat. Commissioners Albro, Bryant, Creighton, Holland, and Tarleton were present.

## CALL TO ORDER
